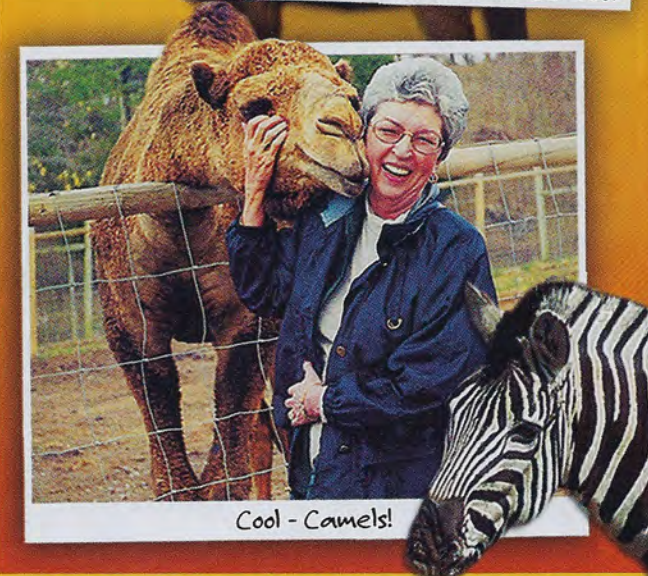

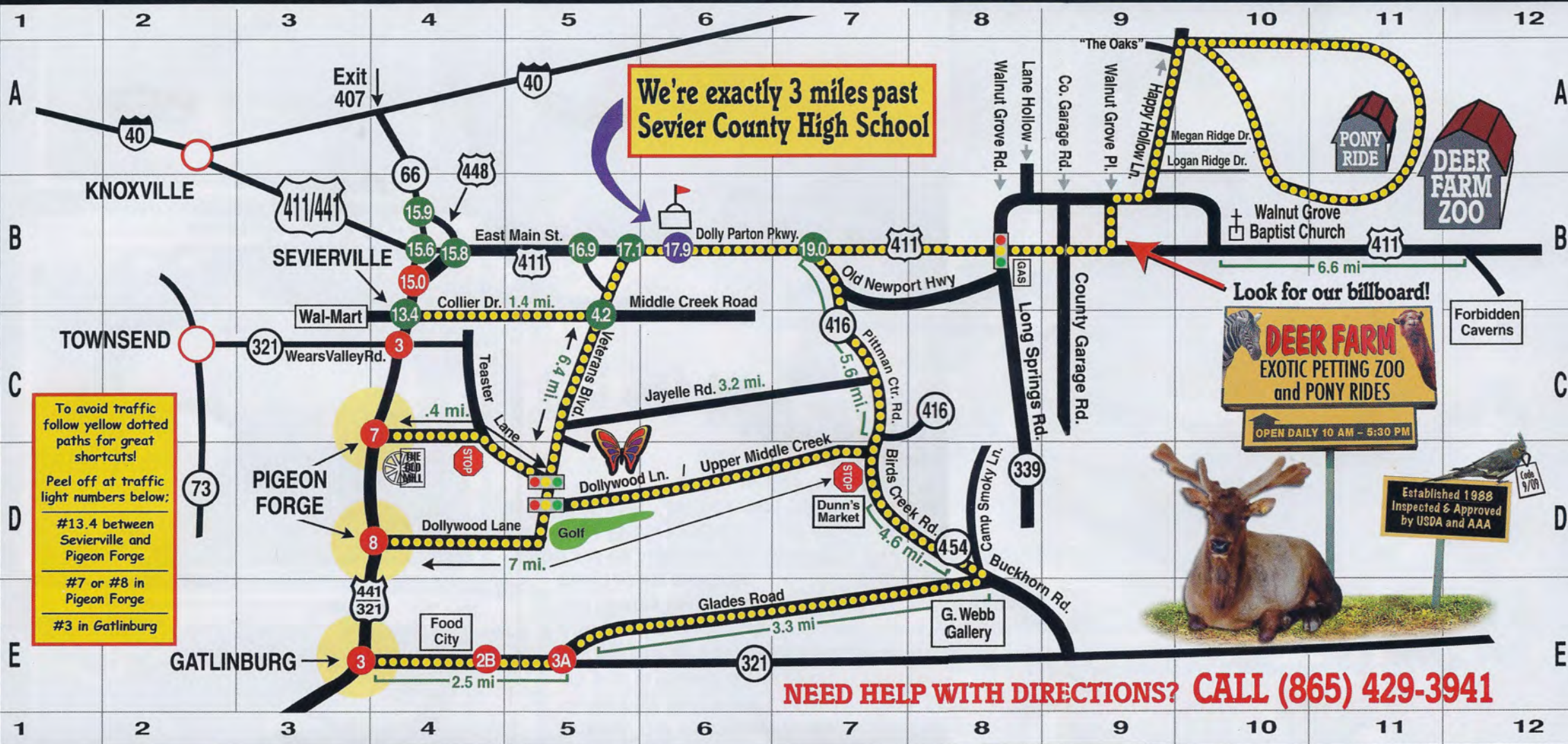

Our facility routinely tests for the few animal diseases which can be transmitted to humans. Our animals are regularly veterinary checked for their benefit, as well as yours. We have a full time zookeeper staff who maintain a clean and healthy facility for all involved and hand washing facilities are available.

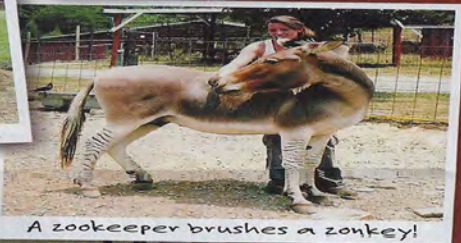

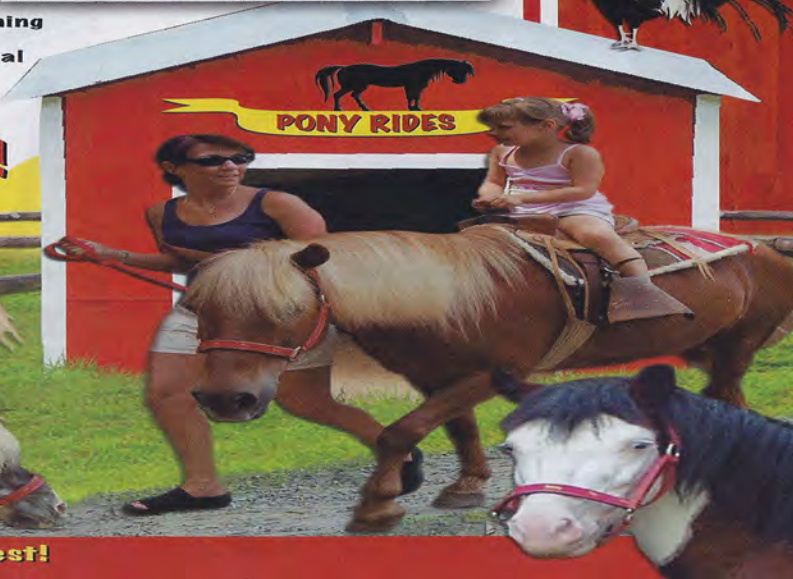
